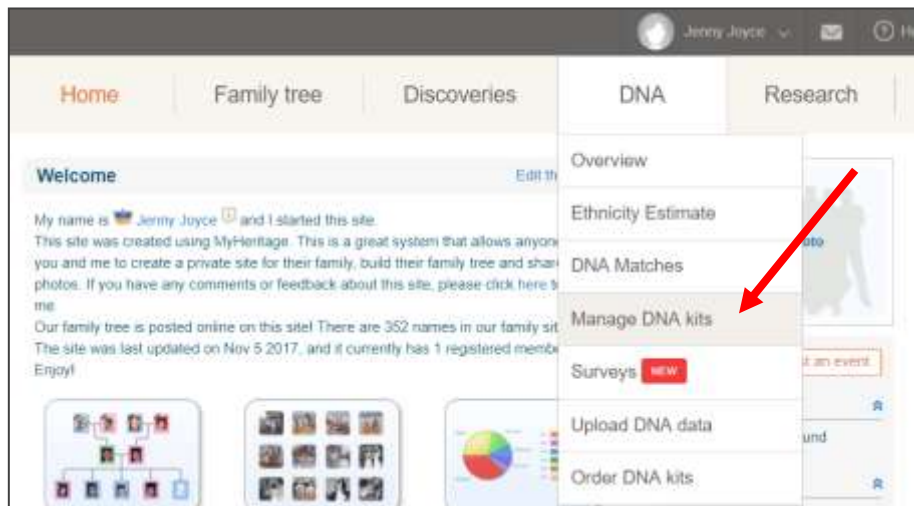


Downloading your raw data from MyHeritage

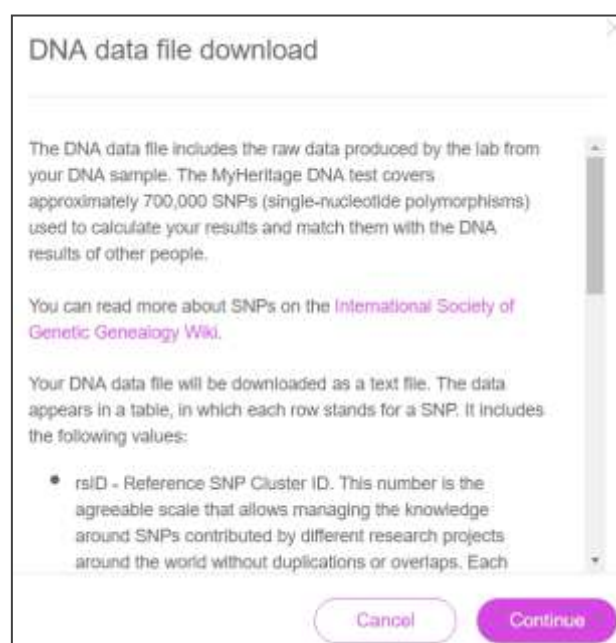
1. From the top menu on the MyHeritage screen, hover over the **DNA** option and a menu will appear below the word DNA. Click on **Manage DNA kits**



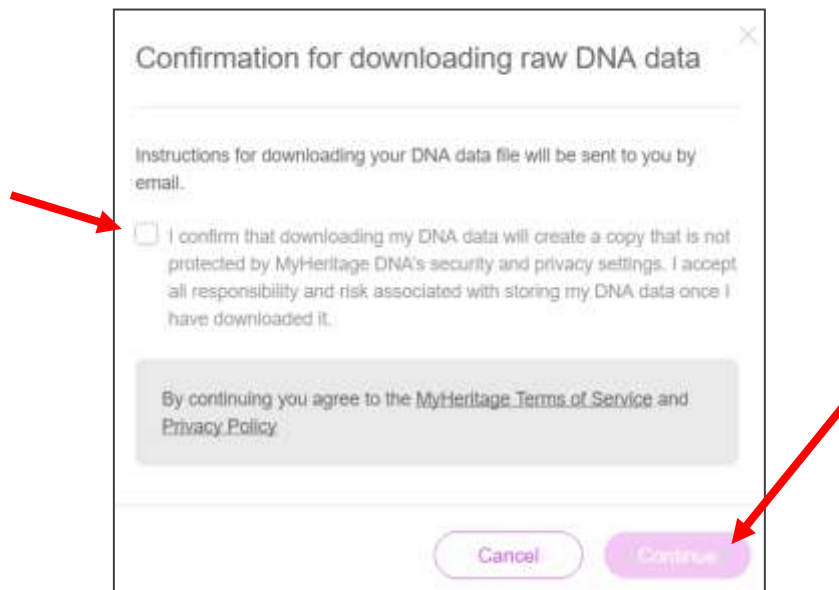
2. You will then see a list of kits you manage. Click on the three dots next to the kit you want to download and a menu will pop up. Select **Download kit**.



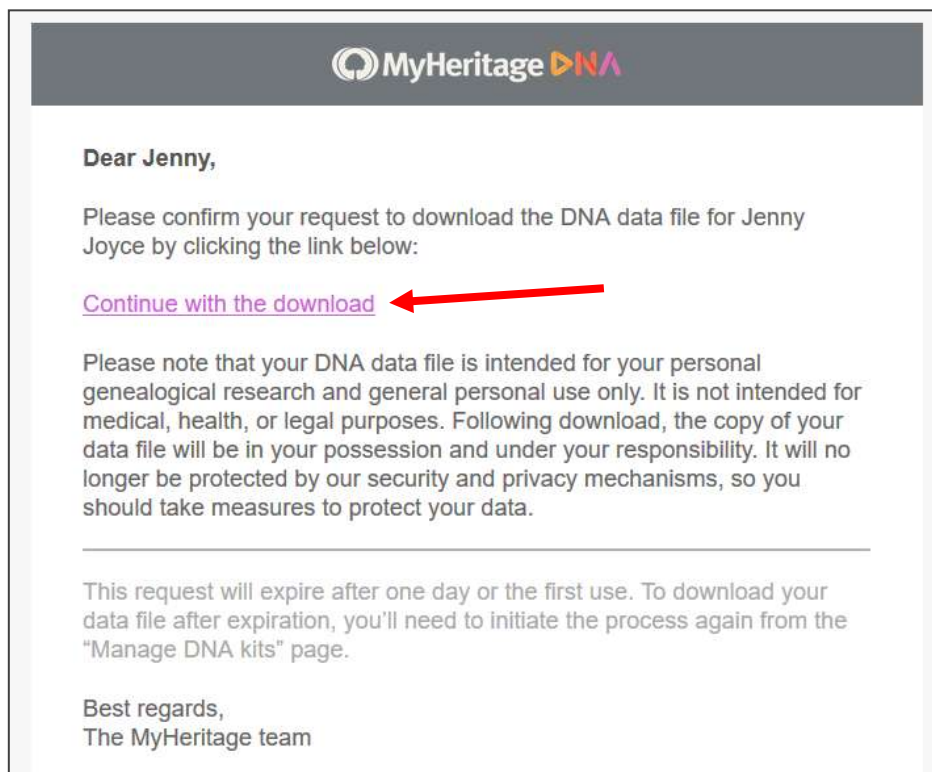
3. A popup will open telling you about DNA raw data. Click on **Continue**.



- You then need to tick the box to acknowledge the information, then click **Continue**.



- You will be sent an email with download instructions. The title of the email will be "**Download your MyHeritage DNA data file**". If it doesn't appear in your Inbox, check your spam folder.
- The email will contain a link that you must click on. Hint: click on the words **Continue with the Download**.



7. You will have to enter your MyHeritage password and then click on the **download** button.

DNA data file download

Your DNA data file is intended for your personal genealogical research and general personal use. It is not intended for medical, health, or legal purposes. Following download, the copy of your data file will be in your possession and under your responsibility. It will no longer be protected by our security and privacy mechanisms, so you should take measures to protect your data.

Information about your DNA data file

The DNA data file includes raw data produced by the MyHeritage DNA lab from your DNA sample. The MyHeritage DNA test covers approximately 700,000 SNPs (single-nucleotide polymorphisms) used to calculate your results and match them with the results of other people.

The data in your file is for your personal use and genealogical research and is not intended for any medical or legal uses. It is subject to the MyHeritage Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy. Please note that your downloaded copy of the file will not be protected by our privacy and security mechanisms. We're processing your DNA file. The download will automatically begin in less than a minute.

8. After a little while a box will pop up asking you whether you want to open the zip file containing the raw data, or to download it. Choose **download**. The file will be saved into the downloads folder if you are using Windows. It is a zip file, but you must not open the file. This is the file that will be uploaded to GEDmatch.
9. Now login to GEDMatch. Click **Generic Upload FAST**
